First impression:

- A cover with a name and class/course
- Use an exercise book or a folder (containing 50 empty pages)
- Leave margins
- A nice/tidy impression
- A nice/decent handwriting

Structure:

- "Month page" when beginning a new month
- Day and date
- Jump a line when entering a new activity
- Warm-up activity
- Share homework
- Activities during the lessons
- New words/expressions written in a framed box
- Talks and presentations (cue cards, comments)
- Transparent punched pocket for useful expressions
- It must be easy for the reader to follow what has happened during a lesson (content/process/thoughts)
- Homework for the next lesson
- Reflection on/evaluation of work: Today I've learned something about... I think today's work/task xxx was easy/difficult/interesting/boring/helpful/hard to follow/good/ xxx, because...

I especially participated in...., because...

- I liked/disliked..., because...
- At the back of the logbook: worksheets, "At the moment I'm reading..." (stories/ newspaper articles/magazines/books...)/ date of report to group or class
