• present your slides in correct English and use adequate vocabulary				
• try to speak loudly, clearly and slowly				
• talk fluently and look at your classmates				
• speak with emphasis and feeling				
• make it exciting and interesting to listen to and look at (facial expression, gestures, body language)				
• present extra material (things to involve your audience) or ask questions
